This is a paid position (approximately \$270 per month) and requires a commitment of a few hours per week. (Hours are variable – some weeks there is little work and some weeks as much as 20 hours). The job requires computer skills and the person must have access to their own computer. In addition, this person must be able to meet deadlines, have experience working with numbers, bookkeeping, and managing an annual budget of \$130,000. Duties also include preparation of profit/ loss sheets for grant writing, transferring funds between bank accounts, and paying teachers on time.
